FUNDING

Your individual lawyer will advise you on their charging rates and any other anticipated costs once they have a clearer understanding of your case, your aims, and any potential challenges involved.

We believe our rates are reasonable and represent good value for money. At the outset, our team will assess your eligibility for legal aid (previously known as public funding). Legal aid is only available in limited circumstances and is subject to both your financial circumstances and the merits of your case.

If you are a parent involved in Public Law Outline (PLO) proceedings or care proceedings (public law matters), your legal costs are automatically covered by legal aid. There are also other parties in care matters who may be eligible for legal aid, and your legal team can advise you on this as appropriate.

If you are not eligible for legal aid for private law matters, we can discuss alternative funding options with you, including whether your matter is suitable for an initial fixed fee arrangement, so that you have clarity about costs from the beginning.

FAMILY MEDIATION

For those participating in Family Mediation, the following costs apply:

- An introductory session, or MIAM is £120 plus VAT per person.
- A one-and-a-half hour mediation session is £160 plus VAT per person.

Although dependent on your personal circumstances, on average one to four sessions are normally undertaken.
